Nature is a feminist issue. UN scientists and policy makers have recently identified women as among the most vulnerable to the effects of climate change and natural disasters. But ecological feminists have long examined the link between the degradation of 'nature' and the domination of 'women', while simultaneously questioning how gendered labor, habits of language, and problematic dualisms in thought (re)produce the 'natural', the 'feminine', and their relationship. This course follows the development of ecofeminisms and queer ecologies alongside, and as a criticism of, other forms of environmental philosophy, policy, and science. **3 CREDITS**
